LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27)

- When planning the 1st hole, the 17th is out of bounds.
- Beyond all fences and walls bounding the course.
- The area of the club house and surrounding gardens.
- When playing the 12th hole, the left side is out of bounds.

2. OBSTRUCTION (RULE 24)

The following are immovable obstructions: distance markers (front of the green) (W : 150m, R : 130m, Y : 90m) concrete steps, stone paths, course furniture ect...

3. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

All old masonry, roads, ruined buildings, trees and rocks...

4. WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26)

All water hazards marked by yellow stakes.

5. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26)

- All lateral water hazards marked by red stakes
- Any unmarked ditches.

6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25)

- Any area marked as ground under repair or defined by blue stakes or appropriately marked.
- All flower beds or young plants.

ETIQUETTE AND GENERAL RULES

- Keep up with the match ahead, not ahead of the match behind.
- Please replace all divots, repair all pitch marks, and rake bunkers.
- Where possible, please keep buggies on concrete cart paths.
- No trolleys within 5 meters of greens or tees.
- Game to be played in accordance with the rules and etiquette of the royal and ancient Golf Club of St Andrews
